Set up in the wake of the Grenfell Tower disaster, the ICSG's purpose is enable everyone in the UK in the built environment industry to access appropriate competences so they may safely contribute to the creation and use of built environments and can demonstrate their competence to others. It is not limited to responding to legislation: it is about keeping people safe.

The ICSG works through its sector led groups, which cover construction products, through to demolition and disposal, including in occupation, enabling culture change in relation to competence as well as collaboration and implementation across industry.
